Tortoiseshell beauty box. Its rim is adorned with a garland of green gold hearts on a rose gold background. At its center is a medallion featuring the same design. It opens with a hinged lid, operated by a push button chased with foliage motifs, revealing three small compartments, two of which are lockable and feature a coat-of-arms in the center. The underside of the lid is flanked by a small mirror. It comes with its original brush, rimmed in gold. It bears the Paris hallmarks from 1774-1780 on the hinges and on the brush ring. French work from the Louis XVI period in very good condition.
