BRONZE "THE KISS" after Jean-Antoine HOUDON(1741-1828)A romantic gilded bronze sculpture depicting a young man wearing a headband over his wavy hair, languidly kissing a young woman dressed in a flowing gown that delicately reveals her bosom; a garland of flowers unites the two lovers, Based on a work by Jean-Antoine HOUDON (1741-1828) Jean-Antoine Houdon: Versailles 1741/Paris 1828 ranks among the most famous French sculptors of the 18th century and particularly of the Neoclassical period. Prized for the realistic rendering of his works and his extraordinary talent, it was at the Royal Academy that the young prodigy won the First Prize in Sculpture--known as the Prix de Rome--in 1761.
