



Around 1900. Pen-and-ink Caricature

Description

A curious caricature, created around the turn of the century, apparently depicting a president of the Republic triumphing over a woman lying on the ground--who could very well be the Republic herself. Nothing is certain, as the message is somewhat cryptic; one reference reads "Théâtre de Bois-Coco, etc.," which may have been understood at the time, but we have since lost the meaning of this allusion. Interestingly, the woman on the ground--and notably--is depicted being thrown into the air below. My explanation is, of course, just a hypothesis. In any case, very much in the spirit of the 1900s, this is a true curiosity. For framing--for a small additional fee, I can take care of it using a period-style frame, such as an oak one with gilded trim, at the collector's discretion.
