The drop-down bronze handles are original, a classic feature of this regional style. This chest of drawers is entirely original, with no alterations, retaining its original patina, though it has undergone a few minor restorations due to normal wear and tear. Its top consists of two wide planks--one of walnut and one of cherry
