Description

The 'Dany' model, created by Émaux de Longwy in the early 1980s, is emblematic of the company's revival: A charming glazed ceramic sculpture depicting a cat curled up in a calm and elegant pose. The softness of its lines, combined with a beautiful ivory-beige crackled glaze, gives this piece a character that is both refined and decorative. The collar, adorned with raised gold cabochons, adds a precious touch that contrasts harmoniously with the simplicity of the glaze. The finely painted eyes give the animal a particularly lively and gentle expression. With its clean lines and stylized design, this sculpture evokes the decorative works of the 1930s, in the spirit of Art Deco.
