Important Raingo Fres and Henri Picard period gilded bronze fireplace set from the Napoleon III era. It consists of a clock and a pair of seven-light candelabras. The set is richly decorated in the Louis XVI style with scrollwork, acanthus leaves, garlands, and mascarons. H: 64 cm W: 47 cm D: 19 cm Weight: 28 kg. The clock, in working condition, features an enameled dial with Roman and Arabic numerals signed "Raingo Frères Paris," renowned 19th-century Parisian clockmakers, framed by a surmounted covered urn with coiled handles. The candelabras echo the same decorative style with finely chiseled light arms. (Formerly electrified) H: 79 cm W: 42 cm D: 42 cm Weight: 17.5 kg each. The clock and candelabras are stamped "H Picard" on the base. Gilded bronze of fine quality in both

chasing and gilding. In very good condition*Henri Picard, 1831-1890, a gilder and bronze artist, settled in Paris from 1831 to 1839 on Rue Jarente and from 1840 to 1864 on Rue de la Perle. He received a commission from Napoleon III to create the gilding that adorns his apartments at the Louvre Palace.
