



Art Deco Dome Ring With A 1.30-carat Cushion-cut Diamond And Rubies On Platinum

Description

A domed platinum ring (hallmark: dog's head) set in the center with an old-cut cushion-cut diamond weighing 1.30 carats, surrounded by square cut natural rubies with a total estimated weight of approximately 0.40 carats, and single-cut diamonds, with a total estimated weight of approximately 0.55 carats. The center diamond is accompanied by a preliminary report from the LFG (Laboratoire Français de Gemmologie) specifying: Color I, clarity P1, no luminescence. Art Deco style, circa 1920, France. Numbered setting. Gross weight: 5.47g Ring size: 52 (diameter 16.50 / US 6.00) Height of the motif: 1.30 cm Condition: slight micro-scratches on the platinum parts, slight abrasion on the stones, a small chip on the center diamond, and slight wear on the setting;
