Maru-gata tsuba made of wrought iron, chiseled in hira bori and inlaid with iroe hira zogan using gilded copper (shows wear), featuring a stylized bamboo design; kozuka-hitsu hana. Signed. Signs of wear. Dimensions: 7.7 x 7.7 x 0.3 cm. Notes: Among samurai, bamboo symbolizes quiet strength, resilience, and integrity. Capable of bending under the force of the wind without ever breaking, it embodies the warrior's ability to adapt to trials while remaining true to his principles. Its straight and rapid growth also evokes integrity, discipline, and the constant pursuit of perfection.
