French painter (19th-20th centuries) - Erotic scene. 10 x 14 cm (unframed) - 36 x 38 cm (framed). Watercolor on paper, mounted on a mat, in a carved and gilded wooden frame. This watercolor belongs to a genre of private art production that was very widespread between the second half of the nineteenth century and the early twentieth century, intended for a cultured and discreet clientele. The miniature format and watercolor technique were typically used for romantic and erotic subjects, a tradition rooted in 18th-century libertine illustration that enjoyed renewed popularity in the 19th century in Parisian circles and European capitals. The scene is set in an elegant interior with gilded paneled walls and a decorative medallion in the background. A man in 18th-century attire is depicted in an explicitly
