Austro-Hungarian Hussar Saber, circa 1750 - 18th century
Leather-wrapped grip (a few tiny holes). Iron fittings. Pommel with a long tail extending to the crossguard. A single guard at a right angle connecting to the crossguard, featuring two diamond-shaped lugs. One of these lugs bears an engraving of the letter X in its center, and beneath the right crossguard is the letter V; see photos. Curved blade with a flat back and hollow edge, bearing remnants of engravings, including a double-headed eagle. Length: 98.5 cm
Blade length: 84 cm
Blade width at the heel: 4 cm
Weight: 805 grs
This saber does not have a scabbard
