Description

French painter (19th-20th century) - Erotic scene. 10 x 12 cm (without frame) - 36 x 38 cm (with frame). Watercolour on paper, within a passe-partout, in a carved and gilded wooden frame. This watercolour belongs to a genre of private production widely practiced between the second half of the 19th century and the early 20th century, intended for a cultivated and discreet clientele. The miniature format and watercolour technique were typically employed for gallant and erotic subjects, a tradition rooted in 18th-century libertine illustration that found renewed popularity in Parisian and European artistic circles during the 19th century. The scene depicts two figures in a bourgeois interior: a young man in 18th-century costume approaching a woman seated in a damask armchair, caught in

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a moment of intimacy. The background features a large tropical plant and draperies, characteristic elements of late 19th-century interior decoration. The technique is loose and rapid, with a confident handling of the watercolour medium, applied in lively touches that animate the fabrics, flesh tones, and decorative elements of the setting.
