Its beautiful, ornate cornice, finely molded panels, hand-forged iron hardware, and original lock with key attest to the craftsmanship of the master cabinetmakers of the Rennes region in the 18th century. Crafted from solid cherry wood, it features a magnificent antique patina--warm and authentic--that has developed over the centuries. The interior is entirely original and offers a practical layout with its shelves, suitable for storing linens, tableware,

The piece rests on curved legs, typical of the Louis XV style, and retains all the charm and character of the grand Breton furniture of that era.
