Description

Carved Oak Panel - High Renaissance, 16th century
An elegant carved oak panel from the Renaissance, of remarkable craftsmanship. The composition features two figures beneath arcades in the classical architectural style, separated by a finely chiseled central motif. The piece as a whole reflects the influence of the Renaissance on 16th-century French and Flemish sculpture workshops. The power of the relief, the softness of the patina, and the still-visible tool marks lend this work a rare authenticity. The shrinkage cracks, past restorations, and signs of wear tell the story of five centuries of history without detracting from the sculpture's impact. Probably originating from a chest or a piece of religious furniture, this panel is today a remarkable testament to the decorative art of the High
