The spandrels, embellished with floral motifs on a sky-blue background, bring freshness and luminosity to this particularly harmonious decorative composition. The warm hues of the frame, in shades of terracotta, ochre, and beige, lend the piece a timeless elegance. This tapestry shows normal signs of wear due to its age, with a few areas of wear and small visible gaps, which bear witness to its history without detracting from its strong decorative appeal. It is backed, which facilitates its display and preservation. Thanks to

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its elongated format, it can be hung either vertically or horizontally, depending on the desired effect in a classic or contemporary interior.
