Graphite drawing on paper, depicting an academic study of the torso and head of Laocoon, based on the famous ancient sculpture preserved in the Vatican. The figure, depicted in three-quarter profile, highlights the model's taut musculature and poignant expression, rendered with meticulous detail and a highly accomplished rendering of form and shadow. Work signed "Louis Aplada" in the lower right corner. Bears a handwritten inscription in the lower right corner: "1st Prize, Marseille School of Fine Arts, awarded to student Louis Aplada, year 1896, Aug.
