Description

Bronze sculpture*Eagles Devouring a Ram* by Christophe Fratin, dated 1838, bearing the Daubrée foundry mark. Dimensions: 43 cm high, 35 cm wide, 29 cm deep. Christophe Fratin (Metz, 1801-1864) was a French sculptor who specialized in animal subjects. Between 1831 and 1842, he participated in numerous Parisian Salons. Early in his career, he assisted his father--a taxidermist by trade--thereby acquiring a thorough knowledge of animal anatomy, which he later incorporated into his sculptures. The work bears the mark of the foundry Daubrée, a firm active in France during the first half of the 19th century. Damage to the back (see photograph).
