Refined pair of finely veneered solid wood and walnut burl bedside tables, embellished with filleted inlays. The nightstands feature a bracketed base typical of the period and a curved front, a distinctive feature of the era. The pair comprises: one with three drawers, located on the woman's side, and the other with a door, typically located on the man's side; both are opened via lost-wax cast bronze handles. This pair of nightstands exudes great taste and refinement, adding a touch of class and antique appeal to any room.
