Medical urinal made of blue-and-white glazed porcelain (China, 19th century) Dimensions: Width: 21 cm Height: 12.5 cm Depth: 12 cm An antique and authentic medical urinal made of glazed porcelain, adorned with decorative motifs in underglaze cobalt blue. Large peonies (flowers symbolizing wealth) appear alongside stylized *lingzhi* mushrooms (symbols of longevity) near the opening, all embellished with scrollwork and other ornamental motifs. The piece features sloping sides, an upper handle, and a square opening. Its shape may have been inspired by an original metal model. Made in the historic kilns of Jingdezhen, in Jiangxi Province (southeastern China)--a city that has been the center of Chinese porcelain production since the 12th century. The object bears
