Description

Elegant living room chiffonier table, rectangular on all sides, with a curtain made of wood veneer inlaid with floral motifs in the panels, beautiful decoration across the entire tabletop, resting on 4 slender legs, the legs adorned with garlands of flowers. A piece from the late 18th-century Louis XVI period. This parlor table can be attributed to Godefroy Dester, who became a master craftsman on July 27, 1774, based on the quality of craftsmanship and the choice of motifs on the leg posts and the patterned veneer top. This elegant and rare small table is presented in its original condition; it can be restored in our workshop upon request for a quote.
