Large round Paris porcelain platter, made in the First Empire style during the second half of the 19th century, under Napoleon III. The center of the dish is adorned with the imperial monogram "N," set within a laurel wreath tied with a ribbon and surrounded by a scattering of gilded bees, emblems of the Empire. The wide rim is richly embellished with an engraved gilded frieze, while the two openwork handles facilitate handling. The reverse bears a red mark featuring an "N" surmounting an antique vase, attesting to high-quality Parisian porcelain production inspired by the 19th-century imperial repertoire. A beautiful piece for display or decoration, ideal for a collection dedicated to the First or Second Empire. Shipping within Metropolitan France:
