Description

A large bronze sculpture with a brownish-green patina depicting "Le Goéland" (The Seagull), an iconic work by the animal sculptor Alexandre Ouline, who was active during the interwar period. With a remarkable sense of movement, the artist captures a seagull in a steep dive--wings fully spread--swooping down on two fish amidst a breaking wave. The composition is highly elegant, blending naturalism with an Art Deco aesthetic and featuring a particularly expressive rendering of the plumage and the swirling water. The quality of the casting and chasing highlights every detail, while the antique patina, with its deep brownish-green hues, accentuates the forms and lends the piece a striking decorative presence. Signed "Ouline" on the base, this sculpture is one of the artist's most sought-after models.
