Description

An elegant Art Deco vase designed by René Lalique (1860-1945), crafted from pressed-molded glass with a satin finish, featuring a polished, transparent neck that highlights the exceptional quality of the glasswork. The relief decoration, finely sculpted across the entire body, depicts birds in flight amid stylized foliage--an iconic theme in René Lalique's work, where nature is interpreted with elegance and refinement. The contrasts between the satin-finished and polished surfaces create a subtle play of light, characteristic of Art Deco-era creations. The base bears the engraved signature "R. Lalique," a mark used during René Lalique's lifetime, indicating that it was produced before 1945.
