A superb print from one of the very first print runs, featuring embossed details in the clouds and on the summit of Mount Fuji. One of the most beautiful prints in this series. Shin-hanga Nishiki-e Tokuriki's series was a huge success with foreign buyers as soon as it was published. This series is undoubtedly Tokuriki's masterpiece and surpasses his other major series, "Scenes of Sacred Sites and Historic Monuments (Seichi Shiseki Meisho)." After World War II, he created another version in the sosaku-hanga style, which he called "Thirty-Six
