Description

An elegant mahogany-veneered chest of drawers with five drawers in three rows, two of which have no crossbars, standing on tall legs, fluted side panels, and small sheath-shaped legs. Beautiful mahogany grain in a fern pattern on the front, with chiseled and gilded bronze hardware, and a speckled white marble top. A sober, "masculine" chest of drawers, classic, and elegant design, reminiscent of pieces by Leleu or Benneman. This chest of drawers bears a faint stamp, but it can be attributed to Crespi--for François Barthélémy Crespi, master cabinetmaker in 1778. Presented in its original condition, this "beautiful" chest of drawers can be restored in our workshop upon request.
