Description

Beautiful Louis XVI-era cane with an 18-karat gold knob. 18th-century gold hallmarks. Eye rings also made of gold. Beautiful Malacca rattan shaft that was originally an umbrella shaft and was converted into a cane; one can indeed make out two discreet traces of slits that were later filled in. These remain barely visible. Horn ferrule. The entire cane measures 37,79 inches in length. Circa 1780.
