Description

This glass paste vase, signed by Camille Trutié de Vareux, better known as DEVEZ, is a remarkable example of French glass art from the late 19th and early 20th centuries. A renowned master glassmaker, DEVEZ distinguished himself through his exceptional craftsmanship and artistic approach, deeply rooted in the Art Nouveau movement. This vase, measuring 16 cm in height, is distinguished by its Orientalist design, created using a double-layer acid-etching technique. The delicate motifs, depicting mosques and exotic landscapes, are highlighted by a palette of warm colors, dominated by shades of pink, orange, and deep blue. These hues, combined with raised leaves and floral motifs, create a striking contrast and visual depth that captivate the eye. The use of the pâte de verre technique, combined with
