Jaeger-LeCoultre ladies' watch, crafted in 750/°° yellow gold (18 KT, Helvetia head hallmark), featuring a particularly sleek rectangular silhouette characteristic of late 1960s and early 1970s design. Its aesthetic is based on an understated and perfectly balanced design: the lugs are fully integrated into the extension of the case, creating a continuous line that lends the watch great fluidity and timeless elegance. The watch's personality also lies in its gray dial--unusual for the brand--which offers a refined contrast to the large white Roman numerals. The gold hands discreetly punctuate this graphic composition, while the crown is adorned with a sapphire cabochon--an iconic detail of prestige timepieces. Powered by a Jaeger-LeCoultre Caliber 840 hand-wound

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mechanical movement, this watch exemplifies the Manufacture's expertise in crafting high-quality miniature movements. The strap is made of black leather and fastens with a gold-plated pin buckle bearing the Jaeger-LeCoultre logo, considered to be original to the watch. Please note that the dial has been restored (repainted), which is noted in its description. Far from seeking a decorative effect, this watch captivates with the purity of its design. Whereas many rectangular watches from this period rely on bolder volumes or ornamentation, this one emphasizes precise proportions, the harmonious integration of the lugs, and the elegant contrast of its gray dial. This commitment to simplicity gives it remarkable modernity and timeless charm today.
