The upper section is adorned with a display shelf supported by two elegant turned baluster columns and a back panel with carved panels, topped by an imposing molded cornice with denticle decoration, typical of Louis XIII furniture. The piece as a whole displays a sober and powerful design, characteristic of 17th-century French furniture. This sideboard is crafted from solid walnut and has retained a beautiful antique
