A very beautiful "religieuse"-style mantel clock, featuring Boulle marquetry decorated with lambrequins, acanthus leaves, volutes, figures in profile, a musician dancing under a canopy, birds, squirrels, four-leaf motifs, etc., and richly ornamented with gilded bronze details such as a winged Victory, satyr heads, fire pots, interlaced friezes and four-leaf motifs, cascading flowers and foliage, resting on four lion's paws, etc. (minor imperfections and missing pieces). Bronze dial with enameled cartels indicating the hours in Roman numerals. Movement restored to working order (suspension modified). Louis XIV period. Very good condition.
