The appliques, moldings, feet, and vent are made of chiseled and gilded bronze--details that underscore the piece's refinement. The oak interior includes two glass shelves and one paneled shelf, providing space for displaying precious objects. The curved legs complete the refined aesthetic of this piece of furniture.
