Excellent quality and condition. Circa 1630, a bust-length portrait of Caterina Giunta, dressed in a black bodice and gown adorned with pearls, a ruff, and finely crafted lace cuffs, and wearing a glove on her left hand--a sign of her aristocratic rank. Inscription in the lower right corner identifying the subject. Unsigned, as are all works by Sustermans, but authenticated by Christie's (stenciled numbers on the reverse).
