Table designed by Charlotte Perriand for the Hôtel des Trois Arcs in Les Arcs, built between 1967 and 1968. It features a thick, circular solid pine tabletop resting on a central, four-pronged base made of black-lacquered steel. Designed for heavy use, this combination of materials reflects the pursuit of functionality and simplicity that characterizes Charlotte Perriand's designs for mountain resorts. Coming directly from the Hôtel des Trois Arcs, this table appears in a period photograph depicting the snack bar designed by Charlotte Perriand.
