Description

A one-of-a-kind piece from the "Carrara Quarry Table" series designed by James Wines for Casigliani in 1989. Composed of four Arabescato marble elements forming two legs, the table evokes a marble quarry in the midst of extraction. Fragments of stone deliberately placed at their base reinforce this illusion of erosion, while a thick, transparent glass top rests on the structure. As the founder of SITE, an art and environmental design firm established in New York in 1970, James Wines has developed a body of work at the intersection of art, architecture, landscape, and design. This table is emblematic of this approach, transforming a functional piece of furniture into a true sculpture. Edition: Casigliani, Italy, 1989.
