The composition is enhanced by jade carvings and decorative hardstone relief elements, giving the piece a remarkable three-dimensional effect. The reverse side is equally decorative, featuring a different landscape composed of mountains, rivers, pine trees, and traditional bridges, painted in warm golden and copper tones against the deep black lacquer background. is one of the piece's greatest attractions. Many antique folding screens feature a more understated reverse side, whereas this example can be admired as two distinct works of art in a single object. It can thus be displayed on either side, serving as a room divider, a decorative backdrop, or a collector's item. Delicate gold borders frame each panel, while the lower sections are adorned with ceremonial objects, floral arrangements, and refined motifs inspired by the Far East. Small touches of turquoise elegantly complement the overall design. Highly decorative, this beautiful early 20th-century Japanese folding screen combines lacquerwork, hand-painted decoration, carved jade elements, and relief ornaments. Details
