Grasshopper Chair designed by Eero Saarinen in 1946 for Knoll. Its bent beech plywood frame forms a continuous line that serves as the legs, armrests, and seat support. The deep seat and sloping backrest offer remarkable comfort, while the supple curves and elegant proportions foreshadow the organic designs for which Eero Saarinen would become renowned. Fully upholstered in olive green fabric, this model is considered one of the designer's first major creations for Knoll and stands as an icon of postwar American design.
