Corinthian-style with twisted flutes, made of molded, carved, lacquered, and gilded wood. One is richly decorated with acanthus leaf scrollwork; the other is adorned with a mustached mascaron forming scrolls decorated with bunches of grapes, framing a putto holding an amphora against a sky-blue background. Dated to the 1st quarter of the 18th century. Height: 217 cm. (minor imperfections, wear, and missing pieces)

Provenance: private collection in the South of France (Aix-en-Provence region). Used since antiquity in architecture and decoration, the column--when judiciously placed within a setting--is a major decorative element for all types of interiors, whether furnished with antique and/or contemporary furniture.
