Set of bisque and bisque lace miniatures -- German manufacturer, 19th-early 20th centuries (Children and cherubs in fine bisque, openwork lace, German craftsmanship) Set of five bisque miniatures depicting children and cherubs, some dressed in finely openwork bisque lace: a technique characteristic of German manufacturers specializing in delicate figurines. The faces are precisely modeled, with gentle expressions, curly hair, and small gilded details on some figures. Dimensions: Pieces with biscuit lace (the largest ones): approximately 6 cm tall and 7 cm wide. Three smaller miniatures: approximately 4 cm tall and 4 cm wide. Set in very good overall condition: Clean biscuit porcelain, with no major chips. Note: Several areas of missing porcelain lace, located on the most openwork elements,
