Bronze sculpture with a golden patina resting on a pyramidal marble base, depicting a nude dancer in a graceful pose, her gaze lowered toward a snake coiled around her ankle. Signed on the marble "Cl.J.R. Colinnet" for Claire Jeanne Roberte Colinnet. About: Born in Brussels, Claire Jeanne Roberte Colinnet was a student of Jef Lambeaux. She exhibited regularly at the Salons des Artistes Indépendants from 1937 to 1940. Strongly influenced by the Art Deco movement, she created numerous chryselephantine female statuettes, her favorite theme being dancers of exotic inspiration, notably the Mexican Dancer, the Corinthian Dancer, and the Egyptian Dancer...
