Noé CANJURA, born in 1922, is one of El Salvador's most important painters. His painting style is powerful, personal, and stylized... He arrived in Paris in 1950, influenced by the frescoes of Riviera. He discovered Courbet and Le Nain but remained within the tradition of his homeland. Gauguin would leave a lasting impression on him with his curves and colors. He exhibited in Mexico, Guatemala, and the United States, but it was primarily in Paris that he built his career. He died at the age of 48. His works are becoming increasingly sought-after and highly valued. Museums have acquired his works, notably
