A Dutch cabinet dating from around 1720, crafted from walnut veneer with rich and varied decorative motifs. This piece stands out for its superb "flamed" walnut panels, its elegant proportions, and its practical interior layout. The upper section opens to reveal two shelves and three small drawers, while the lower section features two large drawers with brass handles. The warmth of the walnut veneer and the architectural design are characteristic of fine Dutch cabinetmaking from the early 18th century.
