Style and Origin These are Imari porcelain plates, produced in Japan during the Meiji era. Intended for export to Europe, they reflect the craze for Japonism in the late 19th century.
Technical Details Shape: 8-lobed rim, typical of late Imari pieces produced for export.
Decor: Classic Imari palette in three colors: cobalt blue underglaze + iron red and gold highlights overglaze.
Ground patterns: Alternating red panels with floral motifs and white medallions featuring peonies and plum blossoms.
Center: Circular medallion painted in blue underglaze with a motif of pine trees, rocks, and birds, symbolizing longevity.
