Gaston THIÉRY (1922-2013)"Gargillesse, Morning View"A beautiful oil on canvas, signed in the lower right corner, depicting the famous village of Gargillesse, a center of the Crozant School. The artist sensitively captures the softness of the morning light, bringing the riverbanks and village buildings to life with a refined palette of blues, grays, and ochres.The reverse of the work retains the artist's original label, listing his address in Fresselines (Creuse), the title of the work, "Gargillesse, Morning Scene," its exhibition number (No. 60 in the catalog), and its original price of 65,000 francs (650 NF).
