Exceptional solid silver dessert or coffee spoons. The widely openwork blades are shaped like a chimera coiling around itself. The handles are decorated with acanthus leaves and rocaïlle motifs that extend to the spoon bowls. Each spoon is hallmarked: A wild boar's head for solid silver with a minimum fineness of 800/00 since 1838. Goldsmith's hallmark "GV" with a stemmed glass for Gustave Veyrat, active from 1894 to 1911. Magnificent spoons featuring spectacular, highly decorative chimera motifs. 13.7 cm long. 89.5 grams net.
