Afghan wool kilim, circa 1970. Very good condition. The city of Maimâna (or Maïmana) is located in a province in northern Afghanistan, on the border with Turkmenistan. Part of Joseph Kessel's novel, **Les Cavaliers**, takes place in the Maimâna region. Kilims woven in this region have always been beautifully crafted. They are easily recognizable by their geometric patterns--simple and elegant--in deep shades of brown, red, and orange. This kilim features a traditional design. Two asymmetrical diamond shapes in the center are framed by various borders: "aleh abassi" (tulip borders), "running water" or "eagle's beak" (hooks), and "göls" (flowers).
