Long Tuareg arm dagger--Southern Algeria, Niger, mid-20th century A type of dagger known as a "telek," sometimes also called a "gozma." Cruciform brass pommel. Locally forged double-edged blade, engraved on both sides with stylized anthropomorphic crescent moons. Leather scabbard decorated with Kano green and a ferrule made of tin and a copper alloy. Length: 55 cm Length without sheath: 53.5 cm Blade length: 38.5 cm Weight: 582 g Weight without sheath: 417 g
