Description

Oil on canvas signed "E. Marcel Laurent" lower left, depicting a lively market scene in Quimper: tall old houses with steep roofs, covered carts and harnessed horses, and numerous figures filling the square, while the spires of Saint-Corentin Cathedral rise in the background. A vivid, luminous composition with generous impasto and a spirited touch, characteristic of the artist's work. 38 x 46 cm Emmanuel Marcel-Laurent (1892-1948) was a French painter and watercolourist, a member of the Concarneau group and appointed official painter of the Navy in 1942. Deeply attached to the Breton coast, he travelled throughout Finistère, painting its ports, its towns -- including Brest, Concarneau and Quimper -- and scenes of everyday Breton life. His works are held at the Musée de la Marine in
