Description

A four-panel screen made of solid mahogany; the upper section is glazed and features lace-like decorations depicting notable figures from the reign of Louis XIV: the Princess of Condé, the Marquis de Louvois, Louis XIV, Madame de Maintenon, the Grand Dauphin, the Prince of Condé, Anne of England, Bossuet, and others. These decorative lace motifs are created using a patchwork of antique elements and others that are less antique but executed with great finesse and producing a highly decorative effect. Only three panels are decorated, the fourth consists of a single lace element. Note: the screen originally had more panels, traces of hinges on one side, and a missing piece of mahogany where a hinge was located. 19th-century. Each panel measures 54 cm wide by 162 cm high.
