Description

An elegant mahogany-veneered console table, featuring a large drawer running along the base. It has a clean, symmetrical structure characteristic of the neoclassical style. Ornamentation: Remarkable gilded and chiseled bronze trim, including a composition of winged lions facing each other in the center of the drawer. The corners are adorned with superb busts of Egyptian caryatids (or busts of women in the classical style) wearing the nemes headdress, extended by palmette motifs. Base: Four square-section legs (shafts) terminating in gilded bronze lion's claws. They are connected by a sinuous X-shaped crossbar, centered with a large bronze motif depicting the imperial eagle on a laurel wreath. Top: Topped by a thick slab of antique green marble (sea green type) encircled by a
