Orientalist School. Julius Starck, oil on canvas "the two friends", signed lower left J. Starck. Belgian School. 92 × 108.5 cm. Julius Josephus Gaspard Starck (1814-1884) aptly absorbed the teachings of François Joseph Navez (1787-1869) and Horace Vernet (1789-1863), his masters in the art of painting. The Museum of Brussels (Belgium) holds his work The Old Café of the Kasbah in Algiers (sources: Bénézit Dictionary of Painters and Sculptors). Our painting is a perfect example of Starck's talent; through a powerful composition, he precisely captures the sense of emptiness that pervades the minds of these beautiful odalisques.
