An elegant bronze sculpture with a brown patina depicting a stylized figure, characteristic of Claude Abeille's artistic style. The slender silhouette unfolds around a flowing drape animated by a fluid movement that lends the entire piece a remarkable sense of lightness and poetry. This work perfectly illustrates the sculptor's exploration of the human figure, reduced to its essentials while retaining a strong monumental presence. The refined volumes, the folds of the garment, and the expressionist treatment of the surfaces attest to the maturity of his work. Bronze signed Abeille on the terrace, numbered 3/8, bearing the foundry's stamp Susse Frères as well as the artist's stamp beneath the
